We understand the concern this incident has caused. Chester Housing Authority is working closely with the Mayor, City Council, City of Chester Police Department, District Attorney's Office, and Violence prevention task force as part of ongoing public safety coordination efforts throughout the city. CHA will continue to cooperate fully with the ongoing investigation. We have learned that the victim was not a resident of William Penn Homes and that the incident appears to have been isolated.

The safety and well-being of our residents remain our top priority. We are looking for ways to support residents and families affected by this tragedy. We will share additional information and resources as they become available.

William Penn Homes is a strong community, and we will continue working with residents, local officials and community partners during this difficult time.
